



**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
OUR LADY OF FATIMA UNIVERSITY, PHILIPPINES
and
BURAPHA UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**



Our Lady of Fatima University (OLFU), Philippines, and Burapha University (BUU), Thailand (hereinafter referred to collectively as the “Parties”) agree to enter into a formal collaborative agreement based on a foundation of trust for the mutual benefit and development of the Parties, and the promotion of international understanding and goodwill.

Whereas Our Lady of Fatima University (OLFU) and Burapha University (BUU) desire to engage in cooperative educational and research activities, for the mutual benefit of both parties, the parties have agreed upon the following:

ARTICLE 1: AREAS OF COOPERATION

The purpose as mentioned above will be accomplished by undertaking the following activities:

1. Research Collaboration
 - a. Exchange of research materials, publications, and information;
 - b. Development and operation of joint research programs;
 - c. Support for distance learning courses;
 - d. Organization of joint research programs.
2. Academic and Student exchanges:
 - a. Implementation of student exchange programs under specific written agreements;
 - b. Development of short-term/ad-hoc academic programs meeting student needs with details and requirements outlined in written agreements;
 - c. Encouragement of academic staff exchange, facilitating reciprocal delivery of expertise in educational programs, both online and onsite.
3. Internationalization:
 - a. Initiation of collaborative research and participation in international conferences, focusing on transcultural nursing, geriatric nursing, and innovations in nursing.

Each Party shall, subject to applicable laws, rules, regulations, and national policies governing their respective countries, take necessary steps to encourage and promote cooperation in the aforementioned areas.

Any additional relevant activities agreed upon by the Parties shall be incorporated into this MOU through mutual agreement and documented accordingly.

To carry out the above-mentioned activities, a detailed plan is to be formed into specific activities agreed upon based on the mutual agreement of the parties.

ARTICLE 2: NON-BINDING LEGAL AND FINANCIAL

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is intended only to set forth the general understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter herein, and does not intend to contractually bind the parties, neither in terms of legal nor financial obligation. The parties may enter into other agreements to achieve the purpose of this MOU.

ARTICLE 3: VALIDITY, AMENDMENT, AND TERMINATION

- 3.1 This MOU is valid from the date of last signature by a person authorized to bind each of the parties, for a period of three (3) years, and is renewed by the mutual written consent of the parties unless terminated sooner as provided herein.
- 3.2 This MOU may be modified and/or amended through mutual discussion and written consent of the parties. Any agreed modification and/or amendment made during the validity period of the MOU shall be made as annexes to this MOU.
- 3.3 Subject to 3.1, this MOU shall remain in effect until termination by either party. Termination shall be effected by giving the other party at least ninety (90) days' prior written notice of its intention to terminate.
- 3.4 Termination shall be without penalty. If this MOU is terminated, neither party shall be liable to the other for any monetary or other losses that may result.

ARTICLE 5: PREVAILING LANGUAGE


